This was illustrated remarkably when there was an offering taken up at the end of the service which turned out to be exactly the right amount to pay an insurance bill for their farm.

However, the question I asked myself afterwards was – should this surprise us? We read in [Philippians 4:19](#) - *And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.* You may have experienced a time when God has stepped in and supplied a need at just the right moment. So often we can have our own timing and our own ideas about how things should be and how God should answer our prayers, but God's provision is always perfect.

For us looking forward as a fellowship, we should be looking to trust in God's provision. As a church we have faced a number of challenges and we need to be praying that God will equip us accordingly. We should be excited by activities such as Messy Church, and when we consider the new people coming in, we should be thankful to God for providing them. Also when reflecting on this personally, there may be areas in your own life where you feel that God needs to step in. My prayer is that you will feel encouraged to know that God provides for our needs and answers prayer.

THY KINGDOM COME

Advanced Notice - 21st to 31st May 2020

Thy Kingdom Come is a global, ecumenical prayer movement which takes place each year from Ascension to Pentecost. Since its start in May 2016, just three and a half years ago, God has grown Thy Kingdom Come from a dream of possibility into a movement. In 2019 Christians from 172 countries took part in praying 'Come Holy Spirit', so that friends and family, neighbours and colleagues might come to know and love Jesus.

From Bangladesh to Brazil, Australia to Austria and South Africa to the Solomon Islands, more than 2 million Christians, across 65 different denominations and traditions, in 90% of countries worldwide have taken part.

In 2019 Thy Kingdom Come was endorsed by a range of high-profile leaders. Her Majesty The Queen also commended Thy Kingdom Come in a speech!

Encouraging feedback from Thy Kingdom Come in 2019

- 92% of those taking part were praying for friends and family members to come to know Jesus – with nearly two thirds (62%) of this group planning to follow up or talk to the people they were praying for;
- 70% of those who took part felt more encouraged to share their faith;
- 40% of respondents took part for the first time this year – which shows this is still very much a growing movement;
- 99% want to be involved again next year.

There is a saying that says "if you don't ask you don't get"
This year we will be again encourage you to pray "Thy Kingdom Come"
both as individuals and together as a Church. We have a great God who can do more that we can ask or imagine. Lets imagine BIG! and believe that God can and wants to answer those prayers.

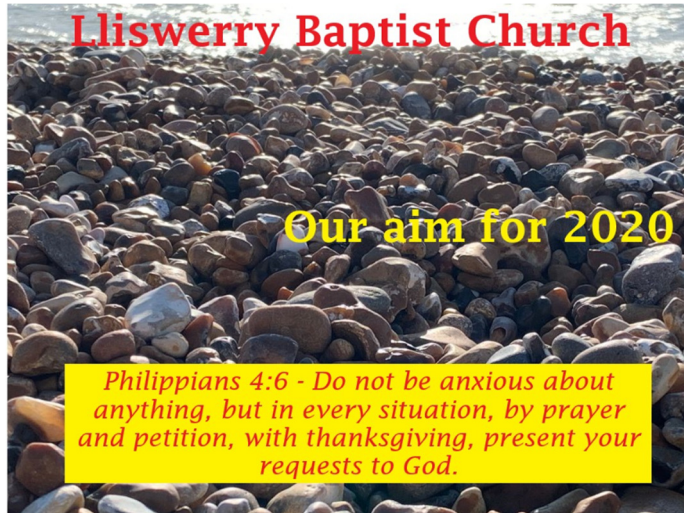
